

## The Catechism of the Crisis in the Church VII -The New Mass

### 54) What is the holy Mass?

The holy Mass is the renewal and the representation of the sacrifice of the Cross. By the intermediary of the priest, Christ offers to His Father in an unbloody manner His Body and Blood, which He offered on the Cross. Thus the Mass is a true sacrifice by which the merits of the sacrifice of the Cross are applied to us.

- **Where is the Church's teaching on the holy sacrifice of the Mass to be found?**

The Council of Trent teaches:

He, therefore, our God and Lord...at the Last Supper, on the night He was betrayed, so that He might leave to His beloved spouse the Church a visible sacrifice (as the nature of man demands), whereby that bloody sacrifice once to be completed on the Cross might be represented, and the memory of it remain even to the end of the world and its saving grace be applied to the remission of those sins which we daily commit...offered to God the Father His own Body and Blood...

- **Is it certain that the Mass is a true sacrifice strictly speaking?**

The Council of Trent is explicit: "Canon 1. If anyone says that in the Mass a true and real sacrifice is not offered to God...let him be anathema." The same Council declares that by the words "Do this in commemoration of me," Christ constituted the apostles priests of the New Testament and gave them power to celebrate this sacrifice.

- **What precisely is the relation between the sacrifice of the Mass and that of the Cross?**

The sacrifice of the Mass has the same victim, the same priest, and the same intentions as that of the Cross; it is the same sacrifice but offered in a different manner.

- **What victim is offered in the sacrifice of the Mass?**

Our Lord Jesus Christ is the victim of the sacrifice of the Mass as He is of the sacrifice of the Cross; it is He who is essentially offered at Mass, and not the bread and wine, which cease to exist during the consecration.
