The Faith

6) What is faith?

Faith is a supernatural virtue through which, relying on the authority of God Himself and moved by His grace, we hold everything He has revealed as absolutely true.¹

- **Does faith presuppose divine revelation?**

Yes, faith is the response of man to the revelation of God.

- **How did God reveal Himself to men?**

God spoke to men through Moses, the prophets, and above all through His only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ.

- **What are the truths that man knows thanks to divine Revelation?**

Thanks to Revelation, we know the attributes of God and His Trinitarian essence. We also know our own eternal destiny, which is the vision of God in heaven. Revelation shows us the path we must follow to arrive at this end: observance of the commandments of God and reception of the sacraments, the means of salvation instituted by God.

¹ The Council of Trent teaches that faith is "a supernatural virtue by which we, with the aid and inspiration of the grace of God, believe that the things revealed by Him are true, not because the intrinsic truth of the revealed things has been perceived by the natural light of reason, but because of the authority of God Himself who reveals them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived" (Dz. 1789).
