It helps devotion considerably to differentiate clearly between the role of God made Man and that of the Holy Ghost (called frequently in Scripture, the Spirit of Jesus) in the work of our redemption. Our Heavenly Father, in His infinite mercy and kindness, commissioned both to this task. The Incarnate God reconciled fallen man to his Maker by the destruction in His flesh of the enmities which kept them apart. "For He is our peace, Who hath made both one, and breaking down the middle wall of partition, the enmities in His flesh...that He might make the two in Himself into one new man, making peace, and might reconcile both to God in one body by the Cross, killing the enmities in himself" The Holy Ghost transformed that reconciliation into a profound mutual sympathy and a strong deep love. Christ merited grace the Holy Spirit moulds souls to the graces thus merited. Christ revealed God to His creatures from without; God the Holy Ghost reveals the same God to His creatures by inward communications. God the Son made Man wrought our salvation by meriting it; God the Holy Ghost wrought our salvation by accomplishing it. God the Son saved us, God the Holy Ghost sanctifies us. To the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity are therefore appropriated all the activities that bear on the sanctification of souls. By appropriation in theology is meant the assigning to each Person of the Blessed Trinity such works as have an affinity with the personal characteristic or properties of that Person even though the operation of such works belongs to the whole Trinity in common. The Holy Ghost proceeds from the Father and Son as the expression of their essential love. He is the substantial love of God, that is, the love of God personified. He is Divine Love existing as a Person, Whose whole personality is, so to speak, made up of love. Sanctity is nothing else than the love of God. The Holy Spirit then is sanctity personified. He is, in virtue of the mode of His procession from the Father and Son, "Holiness Itself." Being such, He is the Author and Source of every work of sanctity.
