Novena to the Holy Ghost

Dear faithful: In the SSPX priories, in preparation to the feast of Pentecost, we usually do a Novena to the Holy Ghost by praying the *Veni Creator Spiritus* every day. However, it is readily admitted that in your homes, you may have a different but very acceptable method of making a Novena to the Holy Ghost. The first day of the Novena is usually, the day immediately following Ascension Thursday. You are invited to join the SSPX members in that Novena.
