Dear Faithful,

The celebration of Easter fills our hearts with joy as we remember the Resurrection of Christ and that this miracle is absolute proof of the divinity of Christ and His triumph over the devil and sin. During Holy Week, by accompanying Our Lord in His Passion, we saw and felt the consequences of sin in the excruciating physical suffering Jesus Christ suffered on our behalf. The sadness and sorrow these mysteries caused us have now been replaced by joy and confidence, because now we contemplate Christ victorious over all our enemies.

Christ's raising Himself from the dead, which was only possible because He is God, shows us the profound meaning and value of all that He did and accepted from His agony in the garden to His final breath on the Cross at Calvary. The sacrifice of Himself which he offered on the altar of the Cross completely satisfied the justice of God the Father by its infinite perfection and merited for us the reopening of the gates of Heaven and the privilege of men being once again friends and children of God. The miracle of the Resurrection proves beyond a doubt that Christ is divine and, since His Passion and death are part of His divine work, it proves beyond a doubt that these mysteries are infinitely meritorious. We are the beneficiaries of this divine work, because Christ represented us in His Passion and death, and He wants to apply His infinite merits to our souls.

However, if we want to really benefit from Our Lord's work, and get access to His infinite merits, we must undergo a death and resurrection, too. As St. Paul says, "For we are buried with him by baptism unto death; that as Christ is risen from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we also may walk in newness of life." (Rom. 6:4) This newness of life is a life of grace, eternal life, which is incompatible with sin. The rejection of sin and the determination to love God and do His holy will is a must, if we want to benefit from all that God made man has done for us. To remain attached to sin is to make Christ's Resurrection worthless for us.

May dying to sin and living for Christ be our determined program in this joyful season of Easter.
